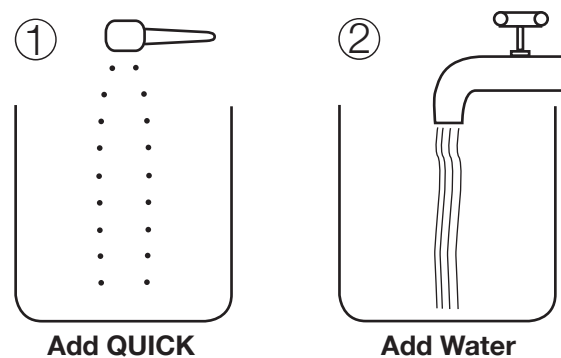

## QUICK Directions:

**Mop and Bucket:** Add one scoop (1 oz.) to mop bucket water and stir gently to mix. Apply with mop.

**General Cleaning:** Mix one scoop (1 oz.) to four (4) gallons (15 liters) of water.

**Heavier Degreasing:** Mix one scoop (1 oz.) to 2 gallons (8 liters) of water.

**Tile & Grout:** For heavy tile and grout soils mix one scoop (1 oz.) to 2 gallons (8 liters) of water. For lighter tile and grout soils mix one scoop (1 oz.) to 4 gallons (15 liters) of water. Apply diluted QUICK to surface. Allow QUICK to work for a few minutes. Scrub thoroughly with a deck brush or automatic scrubbing machine. Rinse with clean water. Squeegee to drain if desired.

**Pressure Washers:** Mix one scoop (1 oz.) with 10 gallons of water by pressure washer.

**Spray and Wipe:** Mix two scoops (2 oz.) in a 5 gallon (19 liter) dispenser with warm water. Fill the spray bottle from the dispenser. Spray on surface to be cleaned and wipe with a clean cloth, sponge or micro fiber. Use clean water rinse for NSF/USDA areas.

**Synthetic Carpets:** Precautions - If being used for the first time, test for color fastness in an inconspicuous area prior to use. **Portable Extractor Use:** Dilute 1 oz. of QUICK per 5 gallons hot water. **For Truck Mount Stock Solution:** Add 5 to 8 oz. QUICK per 5 gallons hot water. **For Use as Pre-Spray (except stain-resistant synthetics):** 1. Dilute 1 oz. QUICK per gallon for hot water. 2. Spray onto carpet via low-pressure sprayer. 3. Agitate with carpet rake, extractor brush, shampoo brush or bonnet. 4. Fill extractor with clear hot water and rinse carpet. After cleaning, re-set pile by brushing with carpet rake.

**Steel and Iron Parts:** Dip or soak in solution containing 3 to 5 oz. QUICK per gallon of water at 160° F. Allow parts to soak. Rinse with clean water.

**Automatic Scrubbers:** Add one scoop (1 oz.) for each 4 to 7 gallons of solution tank capacity. Fill solution tank with water.

**Larger Automatic Scrubbers:** Add one 8 oz. cup for each 27 to 56 gallons of solution tank capacity. Fill solution tank with water.

**Sprinkle Method:** For best results, scrape up caked grease and grime. Wet floor with a large amount of water. Sprinkle a generous amount of QUICK onto surface (1 lb. per 100 square feet). Allow to work for 5 minutes. Scrub thoroughly with deck brush or floor machine and dissolve any accumulation of granules. Rinse with clean water and squeegee if desired. NOTE: For faster action during cold weather, when water and floor are cold, mix QUICK into water prior to spreading on floor. Scrub and rinse as before.

If available, warm or hot water will add to effectiveness.

Rinse surfaces with clean water or remove any residue with mop and bucket or wet/dry vacuum.
